Dear Mr. Macko:

I am writing to invite you, as a candidate, to participate in the Ohio Candidate Voter Guide (formerly the Judicial Voter Guide) that the Secretary of State's office will publish on our website for the November 2010 general election. Due to past popularity and previous publication of the Judicial Voter Guide, we are expanding participation beyond judicial races to include all federal, statewide, General Assembly, and Ohio Board of Education elections this year. The goal of this online voter guide is to provide a uniform format that gives all Ohio registered voters the opportunity to educate themselves about the candidates and the offices they seek in the 2010 fall election. The format of the guide allows a voter to view candidates for the ballot, information about them and the offices they seek, by county, by district and statewide.

Included at the bottom of this letter is your personal identification number (PIN). This code will allow you to sign on to the Ohio Candidate Voter Guide Candidate Submission page on our website at www.sos.state.oh.us/jvg.aspx, where you will be able to securely enter information you would like Ohio voters to see. Information about all participating candidates in Ohio will be posted on the secretary of state's website regardless of whether their race is contested or uncontested, as well as general information about the nature and duties of the various offices. Candidates, in either contested or uncontested races, who choose not to participate will still be listed in their race and will be given the status of "No Profile Submitted."

Attached you will find the guidelines for submission. Please read them carefully. Once your information is submitted, you generally will not have the opportunity to resubmit or to edit the information. The Secretary of State's office will not alter, edit or correct any candidate's information, and each candidate will be solely responsible for the truth and accuracy of his or her statements. Please take careful note of the word limitations listed in the submission guidelines, as the system will not allow you to enter additional words after the word limit has been reached. The deadline for submission is 5:00 p.m. on August 27, 2010.

Thank you in advance for what we hope will be your participation in helping our office provide to the public valuable information in a uniform manner that will assist with voter education in Ohio.
